

PATIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

AS A PATIENT AT FIRST SURGICENTER YOU HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO:

- * Provide, to the best of your ability, a complete and accurate medical and surgical history, medication list, and report changes, as they should occur.
- * Ask questions if you do not understand what has been told or instructed to you about your treatment and/or care.
- * Follow the treatment plan recommended by your attending physician/provider and to follow the postoperative instructions, including pain management, you are given at the time of your discharge. Efforts will be made to consider your specific needs and limitations.
- * You and your family/support persons are responsible for the consequences and outcomes should you fail to follow the instructed treatment plan.
- * Provide a responsible adult driver to transport you home after your procedure and arrange for assistance for the first 24 hours following your procedure when requested.
- * Assure that your financial obligations of your health care are fulfilled promptly.
- * Be considerate and respectful of other patients, visitors, the staff, and the property of First SurgiCenter.
- * Keep your appointment at the scheduled time and contact the staff as soon as possible if you should have a conflict or need to cancel your procedure.
- * Report to a staff member or provider any perceived risks or safety concerns you may have.
- * Follow our facilities rules and regulations.
